Chief's report:

- Excellent work by all at the attic fire 2 weeks ago. Contained with minimal damage to the building.
- Radio Update: The state approved V.23 firmware from Motorola last week. The state just needs to approve the code plug design then Pittsfield communication will program one portable radio for us to verify proper programming. If all works well, we'll get the remainder of the radios.
- 2nd Annual Hartford HealthCare EMS Symposium, Friday, September 24th and Saturday, September 25th at the Center for Education, Simulation, and Innovation at Hartford Hospital. Let me know if anyone is interested. \$30/pp Dept will cover costs.
- Received \$30,000 from the AKC Grant to cover the expenses for the 800MhZ radios and \$1500 to the department for operations.

- -iPads are ordered but waiting for microchips from China. Ship date of Aug 3rd to 17th. Mounts are already in apparatus. Drivers are never to use while driving, distracted driving policy posted online.
- -Recreational Marijuana legalization in Connecticut as of July 1st. The NVFD will remain a drug free workplace.
 - Several Grants such as the AFG require the recipient to provide a drug-free workplace, thus prohibiting use of drugs in the workplace (though not off duty).
 - Do not respond or participate in meetings or trainings while under the influence of any drug or alcohol.
 - Remember that having a CDL will result in a complete prohibition of use, on and off duty, as the CDL & physical, which are federally regulated will fail anyone for having THC in their system.
 - Never be impaired while performing any task at the station or fireground by any legal or illegal drug as this will not only threaten your life but the lives of others. Most functions we preform are considered critical tasks no matter how small they seem.
 - Case in point: If an apparatus was hit or a firefighter becomes injured and subsequent testing found THC in the firefighter's system (even if it wasn't their fault), proving that the driver or firefighter wasn't negligent in their actions is a tough charge to fight against. This may also affect your ability to obtain benefits in the event of death or disability
