Radios: New 800MHZ portables are in service and on the engines.

- TAC2 is our testing channel for 60 days (April'ish) before the state will turn on our talk groups to monitor the amount of bandwidth we will use on the state core. After our testing period we will use our 800Fireground talk group.
- The 800 talk group channels are unable to scan with the VHF channels.
- Officers discussed radio operations. When responding to all calls keep a portable on TAC2 to communicate with each other while enroute. Use the truck mobile to hear updates from

LCD on Dispatch & Command. When you get on-scene use our VHF fireground channel or NW interior as we currently do. Nobody should be using an 800channel/Talk group when you're in an IDLH atmosphere/wearing an SCBA.

- When on scene the Incident Commander will need 2 radios to monitor incoming apparatus on TAC2 and VHF channels.
- A box for spare batteries is in 20,30,& 40. Unable to put bank chargers in the apparatus due to how batteries are charged and reconditioned.
- 27 Portables in total. Please keep them and their VHF counterparts in their assigned truck as they are programmed accordingly.
- All officers have 800MhZ portables (8)
- Emergency Management (2) 800MhZ portables
- Fire Marshal (2) 800MhZ portables
- S20 (3) 800MhZ portables and (2) VHF portables
- E30 (3) 800MhZ portables and (3) VHF portables
- E40 (3) 800MhZ portables and (3) VHF portables
